Basic Requirements

- Candidate must have sound references
- SA Hockey Level 3 Accreditation.

Preferable Requirements

- Previous experience as a national senior head coach, national U21 head coach, national senior assistant coach, or Provincial Head Coach in A Section.
- A minimum of 3 years IPT or 5 years USSA as Head Coach.

Key Competencies and Requirements

- Candidates must have the competencies to work and conduct their duties within the context and systems of operation of the South African Hockey Association.
- Candidate must be able to exhibit competency in strategic thinking and operation.
- The candidate must be able to operate independently and as part of a team.
- The candidate must possess people/personnel management skills.
- Candidate must have a working knowledge of financial systems and policies around international sport teams.
- The candidate must have a good understanding of how sports science should be utilized within the national senior women's hockey program.
- The candidate must have the ability to lead or facilitate a healthy team culture while also prioritizing the well-being of the athletes linked to performance.
- The candidate must demonstrate the ability to utilize technology to aid and advance performance of the athletes
